

## Ayrshire Canada launches a brand new virtual show online.

Ayrshire Canada, in partnership with its provincial branches, keep innovating by offering its breeders the chance to participate in a national Ayrshire show. There's no need to travel: this competition will be held by video right on your farm.

The idea is to choose a calf/cow , prepare it as you would for a traditional show, and present it on video in its best possible light. Your animal will be judged by an official judge.

## Rules

- > The calf/cow must be registered in the Ayrshire Canada herd books.
  - Be at least 87.5% in purity.
  - Belong to a member of the Ayrshire Breeders' Association of Canada.
- The classes are as follows:
  - Calf classes
    - #1: Summer Calf : June 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 to August 31<sup>st</sup> 2020
    - #2: Junior Calf : March 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 to May 31<sup>st</sup> 2020
    - #3: Intermediate Calf : December 1<sup>st</sup> 2019 to February 29<sup>th</sup> 2020
    - #4 : Intermediate Yearling : December 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 to February 28<sup>th</sup> 2019
  - Cow classes
    - #4: Cow 1<sup>st</sup> lactation
    - #5: Cow 2<sup>nd</sup> lactation
    - #7 Cow 3<sup>rd</sup> lactation
    - #8 Cow 4<sup>th</sup> lactation and more
  - A junior and a senior championship will be held.
- Participation
  - No registration limit.
  - Registration deadline: October 8<sup>th</sup> 2020.
  - Competition ends on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2020.
  - 10 \$ fee per animal
  - Video submissions must be sent by October 26<sup>th</sup> 2020 (at midnight) to Ayrshire Canada: <u>felix@ayrshire-canada.com</u>









- Only one video per registered animal will be accepted.
- The video must be named as follows:
  - 111406335\_lacouleeclickersublime\_#4



- Video requirements:
  - Clearly display the ATQ or NLID #.
  - Be a maximum of 1 to 2 minutes in length.
  - Present the animal as it would be exhibited during a competition, <u>walking</u> from every angle and <u>standing still</u>.
  - White clothing is not mandatory.
  - The animal must be shown in its best light.
  - The This does not have to be done by a professional.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  The Association's code of ethics must be respected.

- > Animals will be judged by an official Ayrshire Canada judge.
